kateat is not quite the

be made. However I
have got it well started
now and hope to have
it finished in a fortnight
by which time I think
I should get the Lord
Curzon from Berlin

I have varnished Lord Roberts
as you wished and it
looks very well

I hope you are having a
jolly holiday and enjoying
the country and will be
able to spare the time to
come over here to see the
Lord Roberts when it is
finished We are only
seven miles from Slough
