I am very glad to be able to let you know I am arrived safely here. I am satisfied with everything here and I got even fortunately in the same Camp where Veress is living. I spoke yesterday already a great deal with him. I feel myself again as a human being. Please take my heartiest thank for your kindly help. I will see just to day what pianos are here to practise on but as I heard there are some good ones. I don't know by yet exactly what my expenses will be ~~but~~ I think they will be rather low. For the fare I had to pay 31. Shillings.

I just heard from Veress you are enjoying your Holiday somewhere in the country, I hope my letter will reach you there. I didn't receive any news from you the last fortnight and I trust that you and your dear family are still in the best of health and hope to hear soon from you.
