My dear Mr. Laszlo.

I had no time to acknowledge
your kind letter which arrived the morning I was
leaving for France & Germany. Friday. Dec 20th. So
I take the first opportunity after my return. to do so.
I spent a fortnight on the Continent and made

with the leading Military Commanders of our Army
