for which he asks me to thank you.

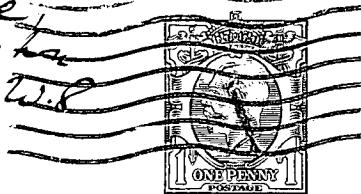
He and Mrs. de László would be so glad if you
