A VERY pretty book for a Chimas present. It costs but one dollar, is "Walter H. Page's Christmas Letter to His Grandson." This charmingly printed brochure is issued by S. B. Gundy. It has a sketch of Walter H. Page, from a portrait by Lario and an introductory note by Surion J. Hendrick.

This letter was written Christmas 1915, by Walter H. Page while he was ambassador to the Court of St. Iames Addressed to his infant grandson and namesake, it contains in it whimsical lines a philosophy of life which could be felt and expressed only by a man possessed of greatness of soul and noblity of character. It will remain as one of the truly exquisite and touching epistolary passages in the English language.
