Mr. Laszlo is a very rapid worker. His London house is a very charming one, full of beautiful things, and with numerous portraits and studies of his wife and children adorning the walls.

A Hungarian by birth, Mr. Laszlo was born at Budapest in 1869, and his parents being poor he began earning money as a boy by colouring photographs and helping to paint theatrical scenery.
