**DINNER AND RECEPTION.****LADY EVELYN GUINNESS.**

Colonel the Right Hon. Walter Guinness, M.P., and Lady Evelyn Guinness gave a dinner-party last night at 10, Grosvenor-place to meet the Prime Minister. It was followed by a reception held by Lady Evelyn Guinness for Conservative members of Parliament and their lady relatives.

Dinner, at which there were over seventy guests, took place in the dining-hall, copied exactly from one in an old Tudor mansion, having walls in plain unstained oak, with a finely-carved deep frieze, a low fireplace with old standards for fireirons, and a high mantelpiece. The ceiling is also of oak, divided in large squares by rounded oak mouldings. The lighting is from a wrought iron electrolier and from high lamps on oak standards round the room. The tone is a mellow tan, and of polish there is not a trace anywhere. Dinner was served at long refectory tables, the service fine pewter, the glass copied from the Tudor period, English glass goblets, and wine glasses on long stems. After dinner Lady Evelyn Guinness received at the head of the wide staircase and at the entrance to the ball-room, which is remarkable for the size and beauty of its cut crystal electrolier, its fine proportions, creamy-toned walls, and white-embossed ceiling. The curtains and hangings are dull jade green. It was used for dancing. Lady Evelyn was wearing a dress of shaded flame-coloured chiffon, made in long and flowing lines, and wore ornaments of suitable colour. From the ball-room opened out two drawing-rooms, one in oak, the other in Egyptian night sky blue. All were decorated with white, red, and yellow tulips arranged with their own jade green leaves.
