**Ottawa War Memorial.**

The names of the seven successful architects, in the first stage of the National Competition for the War Memorial to be erected at Ottawa, for which Parliament has appropriated £20,000, include four British, one American, and two Canadian firms. The British architects are Mr. Lodge, of Bedford-square, London (with Mr. Rosslyn, sculptor); Mr. Vernon March, of Farnborough, Kent; Mr. F. Brook Hitch, of Queen's-terrace, London; and Mr. Wm. J. Smith, Cross-hill, Glasgow.
