LANSING COLLEGE.—A portrait of Canon H. T. Bowlby, the retiring headmaster of Lansing College, was unveiled in the great school on Saturday afternoon, by Dr. R. Sanderson, a son of Canon R. E. Sanderson, a former headmaster. After sixteen years' work at Lansing College, Canon Bowlby has resigned and has accepted a Canon-residentiary at Chichester in succession to the late Canon H. D. Jones. Canon Bowlby received a book containing the names of the subscribers to the portrait, and a duplicate copy was handed to the College librarian to be placed in the College library. The artist of the picture was Mr. de Laszlo. In his speech of thanks, Canon Bowlby referred to the great debt all Lansing men owed to Bernard Tower, his predecessor, and of the loyal response always made by past members of the school to any appeal that the school might make.
