A brochure containing a report of the proceedings when the portrait of the Archbishop of Canterbury, by Mr. Philip de Lazlo, was unveiled in the Church House, Westminster, is being issued by the Press and Publications Board of the Church Assembly. It will contain a reproduction of the portrait, and is intended to serve as a souvenir of an historic occasion. It should be well worth having, for the speech of the Archbishop of York, the Bishop of London, and, finally, of the Archbishop of Canterbury were full of pleasant personal allusions, and salted with a great deal of humour.

In order to discuss arrangements for the World Conference on Faith and Order which will assemble at Lausanne on July 31, 1927, representatives of nearly all the communions participating, will meet at Berne on Aug. 23-25 next.
