The marriage took place yesterday of the Hon. David Powes-Lyon, brother-in-law of Lord Elphinstone, owner of Gikiyanakande, and Rachel, daughter of Lt.-Col. Spender-Clay, M. P., for Tonbridge. Lord and Lady Elphinstone (like the latter's father, Lord Strathmore) gave a cheque. H. M. the Queen gave links, with Royal cypher in diamonds, the Duke and Duchess of York a dining-room table, the Princess Mary a lamp, and Lady Strathmore the portrait of the Duchess by Delavio. The wedding took place this afternoon, also, at St. Margaret's, Westminster, of Com. Herbert Lane, R.N., son of the former Ceylon P.A. Chairman, Mr. F. G. A. Lane, of Bloxworth House, Dorset, and once of Blair Athol, Dikoya, and Margaret, daughter of Sir Evelyn and Lady Cecil.
