Lord Athlone and Princess Alice—respectively the Queen's brother and the King's cousin—will to-morrow celebrate their silver wedding in South Africa, some 6,000 miles away from all their relatives, except their daughter, Lady May Cambridge.

Their marriage took place at St. George's Chapel, Windsor, on February 10, 1904, when they were Prince Alexander of Teck and Princess Alice of Albany.

Among the silver wedding gifts is a portrait of the Princess for which she sat to Mr. Philip de Laszlo while she and her husband were at home on leave last year.

Another present consists of a silver fund raised throughout the Union to mark the affection of South Africans for their Governor-General and his "consort."
