Dear Sir,

Following upon my several interviews with you ~~we~~ now have pleasure in accepting your offer of a sum of £200 to provide the following:-

6 radiator cases for the studio, 5 of which are to be complete with marble tops, pattern of marble to be submitted and approved by you.

One radiator case for dressing room, also to include marble top, marble again to be approved by you.

These cases are to be made to the design as submitted to you and approved subject to the following variations:-

The corner standards to be carried up above the fluted band to allow a space of  $\frac{1}{2}$ " as an air outlet.

The fluted band to have open flutes.

The steel guards in the frame to be left bright, similar to the sample submitted to you to-day, and which you approved but to be lacquered to prevent rust.

Doors to be provided at one end of each of the cases to allow of admittance of the hand to operate the fans.

The price includes for painting one coat of paint only to the frames ready for your decorator to finish the decoration to harmonise with your wall treatment.

This price is a net price, subject to no allowance for discount, and for payment as soon as the work is finished.

I am returning to you my previous estimate dated 4th April in connection with this work as desired.
