I am continuing to demand further £25; and as I have not yet received the £25 I will not send them the 100 copies until I have received the £25.

and today I am able to acknowledge
your letter. After 28. May, I accept the
contents of it. except with the exception

to take these over for not least 60% of my
expenses - of it. Meanwhile I
